

SUPPLY LIST (links)

- Wood sign
- <u>Sanding block</u>
- Tack Cloth
- Stain
- Acrylic paint
- Paint brushes
- Painter's tape
- Vinyl
- Cutting Machine
- Wired-edge ribbon
- Adhesive

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Protect your surface with thick paper or plastic.
- 2. Sand your sign with your sanding block.
- 3. Remove dust with a tack cloth or other clean, dry cloth.
- 4. Read the instructions on your stain to see how to prep and apply the stain. Some stains work differently than others. Also make note of drying time.
- 5. Apply your stain with a cloth or a brush. A washcloth works great! Let it dry according to the instructions on the can.
- 6. Apply a second coat if desired and let dry for the appropriate time. A few hours or overnight is ideal.
- 7. Apply painter's tape to section off where you want to paint.
- 8. Start painting with acrylic paint in that section, painting with long, even strokes, going with the grain. Let dry for 1 hour.
- 9. Apply another coat if desired, let fully dry for a couple hours.
- 10. Spray with sealant. Let sealant set and dry overnight.
- 11. Make vinyl lettering with Cricut or other cutting machine and attach to sign.
- 12. Make bow out of your wired-edge ribbon.
- 13. Attach the bow with strong adhesive like E6000. Hold it in place for a few minutes while the adhesive starts to set. Let fully dry overnight before hanging up.
